

Setting Up Windows XP

1. Go to Start and then Internet at the top of the menu. Right Click on Internet, Click on Internet Properties
2. Click on Connections and then click on the setup button
3. The “New Connection Wizard” will start
4. Select connect to the internet
5. Select “Set up my connection manually” and then click next
6. Select “Connect using a dial-up modem” and then click next
7. Type in the name of the ISP--> IGS, click next
8. Type in the phone number for IGS, which is found on your Personal Internet Information Sheet. For the K-W area it is 883-0646. Click Next
9. Type in the username-->Be sure to use all small letters and NO spaces. Then type in the password and confirm the password. Click Next
10. Click “Add a shortcut to this connection on my desktop” and then click finish.
